Your letter of May 12, 1992, with enclosed Revision 4 to the Processed Water Disposal System (PWDS) Technical Evaluation Report (TER)(Reference 1), provided updated information to the NRC staff on PWDS operations. The initial PWDS TER submittal of October 7, 1988, (Reference 2) was approved by the NRC staff in a letter dated September 11, 1989, (Reference 3). Subsequent Revisions 1, 2, and 3 were submitted to the NRC for information on October 17, 1989, August 3, 1990, and November 6, 1991, respectively. By letter dated March 4, 1993, the NRC concluded that Revisions 1,2, and 3 remained within the limits established by the earlier staff approval.

The PWDS activities which have been modified in Revision 4 also remain within the limits of the technical bases for the prior staff approval. These revisions include the installation of a new blender/dryer which uses steam as a heat source rather than grid resistance electric strip heaters, the addition of a piping tie-in to the Borated Water Storage Tank (BWST), and a change in the name of your contractor. We have determined that the revisions to PWDS TER do not constitute an unreviewed safety question and that the activities described fall within the bounds of the previously issued Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (Reference 4).
