PLANT PERSONNEL PRAISED BY NRC OFFICIAL

An interesting part of the NRC press briefing yesterday has received scant attention from the media.

William Kreyer, a member of Harold Condon's staff, has been in the IMI 2 control room from the 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. shift since last Friday.

He reported in Thursday's NRC press briefing that the plant activity has been "very orderly" and "very professional."

Mr. Kreyer said that "We've observed from the very beginning a very calm, very professional attitude on the part of the staff (Met-Ed) which consists of the shift supervisor, the senior operators, auxiliary operators, and for the first several days, the health physics staff operating out of the control room. These people, in viewing that scene, there's no evidence that there's anything but a very orderly, very professional operation going on."

Mr. Kreyer added: "My reaction from seeing the activity from Friday afternoon on was that the situation must have been well under control even during the early hours, as far as activities of the staff."

That's the opinion of an NRC official from personal observation.

There will be continuous shuttle service from 6 a.m. to Midnight with stops at the parking lot behind the Crawford Station, Trailer City in front of Trailer #1, and the front gate of the 500KV Substation.

NEW PARKING ARRANGEMENT

To alleviate the congestion in the Trailer City Parking Lot and to cooperate with the State Police in eliminating the congested parking along Rte. 441, new parking regulations will be implemented today.

All Trailer City personnel with security badges are to park in the 500 KV Substation. You must show your green or yellow I.D. badge when entering the parking area. Shuttle buses and vans will transport you to Trailer City (unless you prefer to walk). Those issued parking passes to the Trailer City lot are also asked to assist by parking at the 500 KV Substation.

Anyone working on the Island, can drive across the South Bridge and park in the West parking lot below the time office gate.

With everyone's cooperation, the new plan will work. More importantly, we will avoid the necessity of the State Police ticketing and/or towing away cars parked on Rte 441.

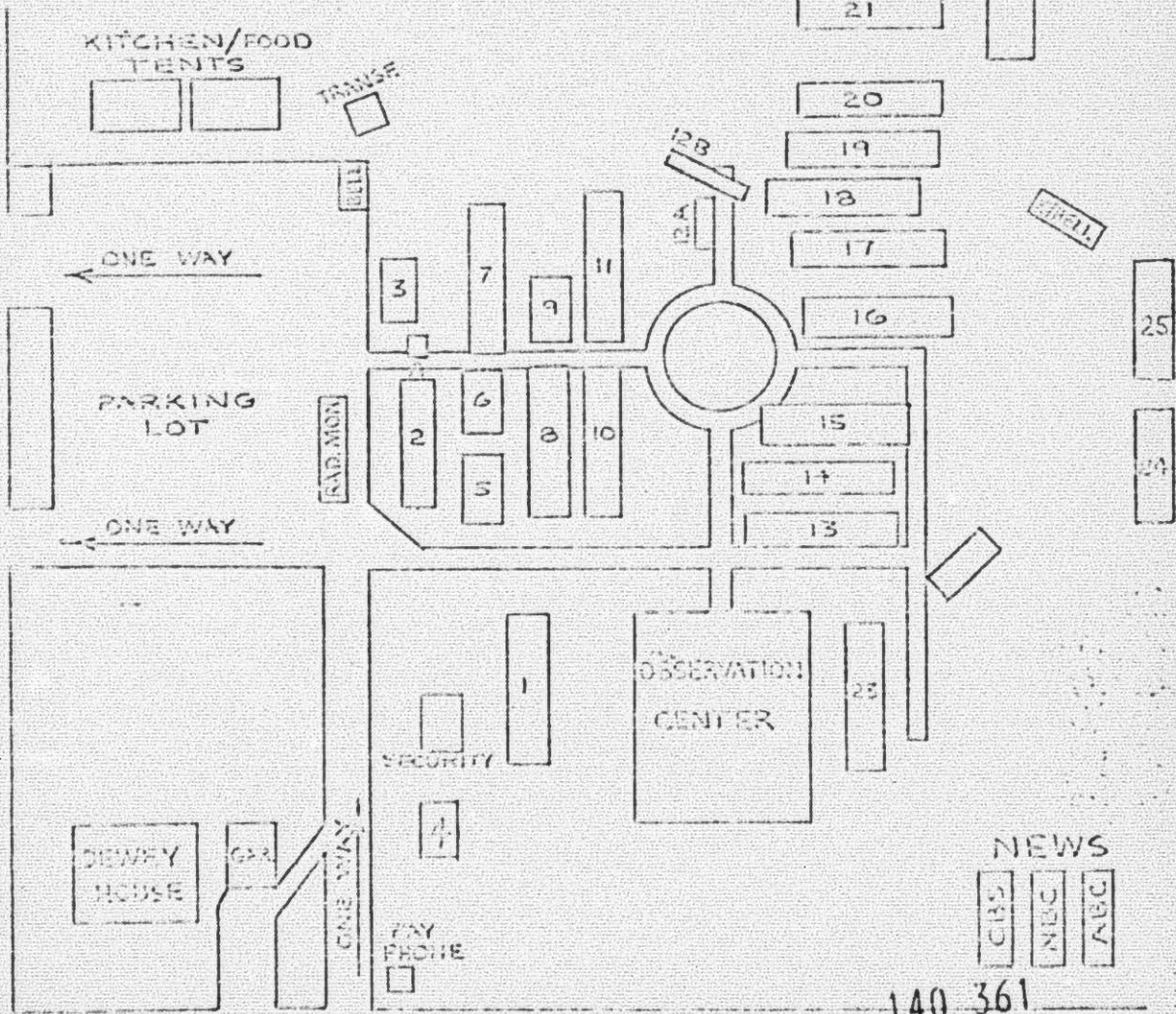
