

## THYAS CAPITOL BACKS NUCLEAR PLANT

Austin, Tex., April 8,.... Supporters of nuclear energy wen a victory here when voters approved continued participation in a 2500mw nuclear power plant.

In that was widely regarded as a believather vote for the nuclear industry after the necident at THT, a \$216 million bond issue necessary to cover cost overrons was approved by 53 persons of the Austin voters....28,430 to 25,037.

The voters <u>rejected</u> a related proposition authorizing the city to sell its 16 percent interest in the South Texas Nuclear Project, currently under construction at a Gulf Coast site about 160 miles to the Southwest.
