Subject: GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION ORGANIZATION CHANGE

On May 31, 1991, Standley Hoch resigned as the chairman of the board of directors, president and chief executive officer of General Public Utilities Corporation. The resignation was unexpected and effective immediately. William G. Kuhns, the former top GPU executive, will replace Hoch until a permanent replacement can be made.

The June 3, 1991, Wall Street Journal, page B5, reported on this organization change. GPU Corporation has not issued a press release but is answering media questions.
