We have reviewed your proposed Revision No. 18 to the TMI-2 Organization Plan. The proposed version, at the corporate level, creates a new Division of Quality Assurance, Training and Education. The quality assurance function is transferred to the newly created division from the existing Division of Quality and Radiological Controls. The training and education function is transferred to the newly created division from the existing Division of Administration. It is our understanding that the corporate reorganization does not directly affect clean-up operations at TMI-2. The TMI-2 organization remains a separate division within GPU Nuclear Corporation with its own engineering and technical support functions.

We find that the proposed revision will not eliminate vital positions or functions within the TMI-2 organization, and it will not change the personnel qualification requirements for these positions. We therefore approve your proposed organization plan revision 18. The enclosed Figure 1-1, Rev. 18 should be substituted for the existing Organization Plan Figure 1.1.
