SUBJECT: ORGANIZATION PLAN CHANGE NO. 24 (TAC NO. 77032)

Reference: Letter 4410-90-L-0038/000P, M.B. Roche to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory

Commission, Document Control Desk, TMI-2 Organization Plan -

Revision 24, dated June 25, 1990.

We have completed our review of your proposed Revision No. 24 to the TMI-2 Organization Plan. The proposed revision deletes the existing Safety Review Group (SRG) and recognizes the Independent Onsite Safety Review Group (IOSRG). The IOSRG will assume the independent safety review function previously provided by the SRG. Amendment 36 to the Technical Specifications, issued on February 26, 1990, modified the independent onsite safety review functions for TMI-2 from a SRG to the IOSRG to become effective upon written notification to the NRC. The June 25, 1990 letter provides that notification and incorporates this change into the onsite organization plan.

The June 25, 1990 request also revises the onsite Licensing and Nuclear Safety Department. Your June 24 1990 submittal states that with the elimination of the SRG the Licensing and Nuclear Safety Department will cease to exist. The TMI-2 Licensing Section, however, will continue to provide onsite licensing support to TMI-2 and will continue to report directly to the Director, TMI-2. In addition, Revision 24 deletes the Special Projects and Construction Support Group, any reference to licensed operators from the TMI-2 Organization Plan, and places the Program Controls function within the Site Operations Department. You state that all three of these changes are the result of an overall reduction in the TMI-2 operation after the recent mode changes.

Although not reflected on the Organization Plan we understand that you are being reassigned to senior management duties within the GPU Service Corporation and R.L. Long will assume responsibilities as Director, TMI-2. Based on conversations with your staff and the June 25, 1990 submittal R.L. Long will assume the role of Director, TMI-2 in addition to his current responsibilities as Vice President and Director of Corporate Services Division, GPU Nuclear Corporation and will be based in Parsipanny, New Jersey.

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The proposed changes will not eliminate any vital positions or functions within the TMI-2 organization, nor will it change the personnel qualifications for these positions. The changes are consistent with the current Technical Specifications for TMI-2 and represent an organizational realignment consistent with the progress of the cleanup. We, therefore, approve your proposed Organization Plan Revision 24. The enclosed Figure 1.2, Rev. 24 should be substituted for existing GPUN Organization Plan, Figure 1.2. This change will become effective on July 1, 1990.

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
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FIGURE 1.2 ORGANIZATION PLAN TMI-2
