The Commission met with the Advisory Panel for the Decontamination of TMI-2 to obtain the Panel's views on the cleanup activities at TMI-2 and related matters.

The Commission directed the ACRS to review measures being implemented by GPUNC to preclude the possibility of recriticality during the TMI-2 defueling. The NRC staff is to provide the ACRS with information on the staff's evaluation of this issue.

The Commission directed the staff to prepare an analysis of the schedule slippage in the cleanup operation at TMI-2 during the period from July 1985 to October 1985. The analysis should examine the causes of the scheduling slip, the effect of the delay on the overall cleanup schedule and any steps the licensee has taken, as a result of the delay, to assure future compliance with the schedule.
