The Commission requested the licensee to:

- a. Make available to the staff the reports generated by the Radiation Hazards Panel to the Safety Advisory Board, TMI-2.
- b. Inform the staff of the resolution of the evaporator qualification issues prior to evaporating the contaminated water.
- c. Continue to focus and document the lessons learned from both the accident and the cleanup activities.
- d. Continue to provide adequate resources to the cleanup of Unit 2 and good operating performance at the Three Mile Island, Unit 1 plant.

Dr. Robert Martson requested that the report, "Three Mile Island Revisited: 1989, A Report of the Radiation Hazards Panel to the Safety Advisory Board, TMI-2," be made part of the meeting record.
