I. SECY-89-089 - Effectiveness Review of Final Initial
Decision - Disposal of Accident-Generated Water at TMI-2

The Commission, by a 5-0 vote,* approved an order which finds that the Licensing Board decision granting General Public Utilities application for an operating license amendment that would delete prohibitions on disposal of the accident-generated water should be made immediately effective.

* Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." Commissioner Carr, however, had previously indicated that he would approve this paper and had he been present he would have affirmed his prior vote.

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
